

Примерная итоговая контрольная работа 8 класс 2025-2026 уч.г. английский язык

Система оценивания выполнения заданий комплексной контрольной работы по английскому языку

Работа №1 состоит из трёх разделов: «Лексика», «Грамматика», «Смысловое чтение», «Письмо, заполнение формуляров и таблиц».

Раздел 1 («Лексика») содержит 3 задание «подбор синонимов» - 100 баллов, «лексическая сочетаемость» - 16 баллов, «семантическое значение в контексте» - 10 баллов и оценивается весь раздел в 40 баллов, 2 балла за каждый правильный ответ в заданиях “А” “В” и один балл за каждый правильный ответ в задании “С”. Время на выполнение заданий раздела 1 составляет 15 минут.

Раздел 2 («Грамматика») проверяет знание неличных форм глагола и содержит 1 задание, оценивается в 20 баллов, 2 балла за каждый правильный ответ. Время на выполнение заданий раздела 2 составляет 5 минут.

Раздел 3 («Словообразование») состоит из 1 задания. В задании 5 вопросов за каждый правильный ответ выставляется 2 балла, за всё задание 10 баллов. Время на выполнение заданий раздела 2 составляет 3 минут.

Раздел 4 («Чтение») содержит 1 задание на смысловое, содержит 5 вопросов и оценивается в 10 баллов, 2 балла за каждый правильный ответ. Время на выполнение заданий раздела 2 составляет 7 минут.

Раздел «Письмо» содержит 1 задание на заполнение таблицы и оценивается в 10 баллов.

Перевод баллов в оценки производится согласно положению о проверке.

За выполнение всей работы экзаменуемый получает 100 баллов.
